Taxis To Bloom for Their 100th Anniversary



THE INDUSTRY HAS FLOWERED Mayor Bloomberg announced yesterday that, along with thousands of volunteers, children from around the city will paint large, colorful flowers on decals that will be applied to New York City's yellow taxis beginning in September. The program, in honor of the 100th anniversary of the first metered taxi, is a partnership between Design Trust for Public Space and the Taxi and Limousine Commission.
